As you are applying to be part of the Leadership Team, our expectations are that you are trustworthy, able to follow instructions and have a mature and responsible approach to fellow Scouts and Leaders.

The **BIVOUAC LEADER** badge is presented following our on going assessment of your attitude, respect and behaviour throughout all Bivouac activities you attend.
